Overview

Paul is writing to a church that is moving away from the gospel of grace (Gal 1:6) and seeks to bring them back on track. So, before Paul says *“if you live by the Spirit, walk by the Spirit”* (Gal 5:25) he wants to make sure they are first rooted in the good news *“that no one will be justified by the works of the law but through faith in Christ Jesus”* (Gal 2:16), and that they have received *“the promise of the Spirit through faith”* (Gal 3:14).

Believe the good news & receive the Holy Spirit

- Why is it important that we understand and live out from the goodness of God’s grace; and receive the promise and power of the Holy Spirit?

Expect growth

Paul's expectation is that we will grow in Christlikeness (Gal 4:19) both as individuals and as a community of Christ followers, and we do this as we walk by the Spirit (Gal 5:16-26)

- What does it look like in our everyday lives to walk by the Spirit & grow in the fruit of the Spirit?
