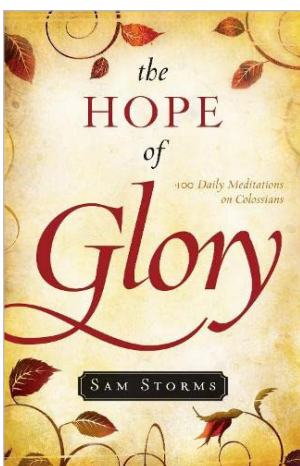
## What is the series about?

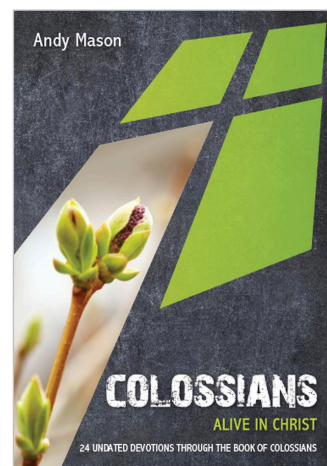

## **Title: New life in him**

Bible Ref: Colossians 2:9-18

### **Overview**

Our true identity is not in what we do, what we have done, or what someone might have done to us. When we define ourselves by these things they govern our sense of self-worth, which in turn affects our behaviour and decision-making. In Colossians 2 Paul reminds us our new identity is found in Jesus Christ, based purely on who Jesus is and what he has done for us, in his death and resurrection.

1. What things do you think people typically build their identity on and why? What have you built your identity on in the past?
2. Are there any influences that tempt you to search for greater 'spiritual maturity' in things other than your relationship with Jesus?
3. Which elements of your old self, which was put off by Christ, do you find seem to creep back into your life sometimes? Why do you think this is?
4. Describe how your thinking, desires and behaviour have changed as a result of being born again, and your identity being in Jesus.
5. In what ways are you looking to grow to become more like Jesus?
6. If you're following Jesus and you haven't been baptised, what is stopping you?
